**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS,
APPROVING THE ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT
CSJ # 0914-04-301 FOR A TRANSPORTATION
ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM MPO SELECTED ON AND
OFF-SYSTEM PROJECT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAGO
VISTA AND THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lago Vista (“City Council”) finds it to be in the public interest, and necessary for the public health, safety and welfare to participate in a federal program providing funding to local governments for certain transportation improvements; and

WHEREAS, the accompanying *Advanced Funding Agreement CSJ # 0914-04-301 for a Transportation Alternatives Program Project MPO Selected On and Off-System* (“Funding Agreement”) is reasonable and acceptable; and

WHEREAS, the Funding Agreement will enable the construction of ADA compliant sidewalks, traffic calming devices, ADA ramps, crosswalks, signage, bus stop improvements, and pedestrian striping on Bar K Ranch Road at Lago Vista Middle School and surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lago Vista has the legal and financial capacity to satisfy its obligations under the Funding Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAGO VISTA, TEXAS:

1. That the City Council hereby approves the *Advanced Funding Agreement CSJ # 0914-04-301 for a Transportation Alternatives Program Project MPO Selected On and Off-System* (“Funding Agreement”).
2. That it be further resolved that the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Funding Agreement on behalf of the City of Lago Vista.
3. That it be further resolved that the City Council directs City staff to cooperate fully with the Texas Transportation Commission, Texas Department of Transportation, and Federal Highway Administration as necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Funding Agreement.

4. That it be further resolved that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.
