

**OFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL

MARCH 18, 2011**

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 18th day of March, A.D., 2011, the City Council held a Special Meeting at 4:00 P.M., at City Hall, 5803 Thunderbird, in said City, there being present and acting the following:

Mayor Kruger called the Special Meeting to order and recognized that all Council Members were present except D'Anne Gloris.

ACTION ITEMS:

1. Mayor Kruger recused himself from the discussion and voting on this particular agenda item. He then turned the meeting over to Council Member Darrel Hunt. City Attorney Paige Saenz recommended the Council convene into executive session.

At 4:05 p.m., Council Member Darrel Hunt announced the City Council will convene into Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, and Section 1.05, Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct to receive legal advice regarding qualifications of candidate for the May 14 general City election.


At 4:29 p.m., Council Member Darrel Hunt reconvened the Special Meeting and announced that no action was taken in Executive Session.

Dale Mitchell made a motion that the Council continue to enforce the Charter with regard to the qualifications that are stated for City public office, and in this particular case, the statement that says no candidate can be in arrears to the city, and if so, that candidate will be disqualified as a candidate. Bob Bradley seconded the motion. Dale Mitchell amended his motion to include "as of the effective date of filing". Bob Bradley seconded the amendment. The Council voted unanimously to continue to enforce the Charter with regard to the qualifications that are stated for City public office, and in this particular case, the statement that says no candidate can be in arrears to the city, and if so, that candidate will be disqualified as a candidate, as of the effective date of filing.

Council Member Darrel Hunt turned the meeting back over to Mayor Kruger.

Mayor Kruger adjourned the meeting at 4:31 p.m.
