Mayor Kruger called the Regular Meeting to order and recognized that all Council Members were present except Dale Mitchell.

PUBLIC HEARING:

1. Mayor Kruger stated the purpose of the public hearing is to receive public comment regarding the proposed annexation of all portions of that certain tract or parcel of land not previously annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Lago Vista, Texas, said tract or parcel of land being 10.747 acres, more or less, located in Travis County, Texas, out of the M.F. Campbell Survey 98, being out of and a portion of a called 334.88 acre tract described in a deed recorded and filed in the Real Property Records of Travis County in Volume 12586, Page 964, and being the same property described in a deed recorded and filed in the Real Property records of Travis County in Volume 13100, page 553, including abutting roadways and rights-of-way, also known as 5300 Lohman Ford Road.

Mayor Kruger opened the floor for comments from the audience.

Paul Wallace, of 5100 Lohman Ford Road, spoke in opposition to the annexation.

Trey Smith, of 19921 Rancho Cielo Court, spoke in opposition to the annexation.

Michael Bridges, of 4002 Clinton Lane and owner 19933 Rancho Cielo Court, spoke in opposition to the annexation.

Mike Wagner, owner of a lot on Rancho Cielo Court, expressed concern with regard to potential commercial uses across the road from the High School and the safety of kids.

There being no further comments, Mayor Kruger closed the public hearing at 9:32 p.m.

ACTION ITEMS:


