# Loose Dogs



As the population of Lago Vista continues to grow, so does the population of our furry little friends! We would like to stress the importance of registering your dogs with the Lago Vista Police Department...Why?

If Officers find your **LICENSED/REGISTERED** dog running around Lago Vista, the Officer may simply be able to return the dog to you and everyone will be safe and sound. But if the officer cannot identify the dog, nor its residence, the dog will be collected and then sent to the pound for adoption.

The owner may also be issued citations for the loose dog!

A small fee applies to register the dog, but it is small compared to a possible citation.

The Police Department has also responded to multiple dog bites this year, where a citizen was simply just walking/running on the roadway, and approached by aggressive dogs. Please keep your dogs leashed/fenced to prevent this from happening.

We want every citizen to feel safe when they are walking the streets of Lago Vista. If you have questions on how or as to why a dog needs to be registered, please feel free to call the police department and request to speak with Officer Orrison or Officer Cochran.

# PROPERTY CRIMES

## **Criminal Mischief— Lakefront Drive**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a complainant stated that his mailbox had been vandalized. Officers observed the mailbox to be knocked down from the post. This case is under investigation.

## **Criminal Mischief— Point Cove**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a complainant stated that uninvited persons had shown up to a residence for a party. The subjects were asked to leave, but became aggressive before doing so. The homeowner then swung at their vehicle with a broom, causing damage. This case is under investigation.

## **Burglary of a Building— Cowpoke Trail**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a complainant stated that his shed had been broken into. Some items were taken and logged in the report. This case is under investigation.

## **Theft— Rimrock Court**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a complainant stated he had digitally tracked his package being delivered but later arrived to find that it had been stolen. This case is under investigation.

## **Theft— Henry Avenue**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a complainant stated her stepson had taken her tablet PC without her permission and she wanted to pursue charges. The suspect, a juvenile, was arrested for the offense.

# PROPERTY CRIMES

## **Theft— American Drive (The Island)**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a bicycle was stolen from The Island, from the garage area. This case is under investigation.

## **Credit/Debit Case Abuse— Lohman Ford**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a complainant stated that someone had used his debit/credit card without authorization at select businesses. This case is under investigation.

## **Fraudulent Use of Identifying Information— Circulo Drive**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a fraudulent Verizon Wireless account was opened in the complainants name. This case is under investigation.

## **Theft— Thunderbird Street**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a complainant stated he was prepping household items for relocation and had left some of the items outside overnight. The complainant stated that the next morning, select items were missing from the front yard. This case is under investigation.

# CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

## **Assault: Family Violence— High Drive**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which a mother had been assaulted by her juvenile son. The son was arrested for the offense.

## **Sexual Assault of a Child— Coyote Trail**

The incident reported occurred several years ago & the case is under investigation.

## **Enticing a Child - Thunderbird**

Officers were dispatched to a call in which the complainant stated that their child had come and told them that a male subject in a pickup truck had offered them candy if they got into his truck. The children ran off and told their parents. One of the parents recorded the license plate number and observed the driver. With this information, detectives have a suspect identified. This case is under investigation.

# DRUGS / NARCOTICS / ALCOHOL

## **Possession of a Controlled Substance— Lago Vista High School**

Officers were dispatched to the LVMS in reference to the assistant principal who had a student in possession of a control substance. The student, a juvenile, was placed into custody and charged for possession of the controlled substances.

## **Possession of Marijuana— Bar K (Traffic Stop)**

Officers on patrol conducted a traffic stop which resulted in the driver being arrested for possession of marijuana., a class 'B' misdemeanor.

## **Possession of drug paraphernalia— Lago Vista High School**

Officers were dispatched to the LVHS in reference to the assistant principal who had a student in possession of drug paraphernalia. The student could not be charged for the offense due to it being a Class C misdemeanor while on school property. The case will be forwarded to the Lago Vista Municipal Court.

## **Possession of drug paraphernalia— Bar K (Traffic Stop)**

Officers on patrol conducted a traffic stop which resulted in the driver being cited for possession of drug paraphernalia. The driver was caught in possession of a pipe used for smoking marijuana.

## **Possession of drug paraphernalia— FM 1431**

Officers on patrol conducted a traffic stop which resulted in a passenger being cited for possession of drug paraphernalia. A passenger was caught in possession of a pipe used for smoking marijuana.

# DRUGS / NARCOTICS / ALCOHOL

## **Public Intoxication — Lago Vista POA**

Officers were dispatched to the Lago Vista POA 'Fishing Well' in reference to an intoxicated person. Upon their arrival, the male subject was located and deemed to be a danger to himself or others if left unattended. The subject was arrested for the offense of Public Intoxication.

## **Possession of drug paraphernalia / Minor in Possession of Alcohol— FM 1431**

Officers on patrol conducted a traffic stop which resulted in the driver being cited for possession of drug paraphernalia and being in possession of an alcoholic beverage, since she was minor.

## **Possession of drug paraphernalia— Cactus Bend**

Officers on patrol located a suspicious vehicle. Officers investigated which resulted in the charge of possessing drug paraphernalia.

# OTHER

## **Disorderly Conduct— Lago Vista Golf Course**

Officers were dispatched to a complainant reporting that a male subject who was a golfer had pulled over his golf cart and began urinating in his back yard. The complainant approached the subject and the subject drove off in his golf cart. The subject was later identified and issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.
